Chicago (November 1, 2004) – The Cosmetic Surgery Foundation is pleased to announced Adil Ceydeli, MD, MS as the winner of the 2005 Richard C. Webster, MD Resident Paper Contest for his paper, "Tear-Drop Augmentation Mastopexy: A Technique to Augment Superior Pole Hollow." Dr. Ceydeli will present his award-winning research at the American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery's 21st Annual Scientific Meeting, to be held January 27-30, 2005 at The Manchester Grand Hyatt in San Diego, California.

Ceydeli received his medical degree from Hacettepe Medical School, Ankara, Turkey, and continued his education in biomedical sciences at the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey. He started clinical training in trauma surgery and is currently Chief Resident in the New York Methodist Hospital Department of Surgery.

Committed to innovative research, Ceydeli has been recognized previously for his contributions to medicine by the American College of Surgeons and the Association for Academic Surgery. He has done extensive research in cell biology and histology and molecular biology and has been published in a number of scientific journals.
