The evebrows also lose their secure attachments to the underlying bone and drop downward, making matters worse. The already saggy eyelids, with the additional weight of the brows, are even prone to vision problems."

BETTER AT BAY

No one is immune to the march of time. Standard procedures such as face-lifts tackle age-related sagging, but rely on pulling facial skin taught and removing excess fat rather than fixing the underlying problems. Wrinkles will disappear following a face-lift, but the face can take on an unnatural appearance. Dr. Ceydeli offers a solution.

This unique procedure—called MAG-5 (Magnificent Five)—

repairs gravity's effects rather than masking them. The advanced procedure solves age-related changes by simultaneously repairing areas around the eyes, brows, and mid-face. MAG-5 elevates and secures the brows to their original position, removes frown muscles and related wrinkles between the brows: removes the excess skin and fat from the lower eyelids and restores their tone and shape; and rejuvenates the mid-face by moving the droopy cheek fat pad back to its original location. The combination of the five areas transformed by MAG-5 allows the face to have a youthful appearance while maintaining facial features that are unique to each individual.

"With the MAG-5 operation, the face undergoes a restoration, not a transformation," says

Dr. Ceydeli, who recently completed an advanced aesthetic fellowship on elective cosmetic surgeries. Dr. Ceydeli studied under renowned plastic surgeon Robert Flowers, M.D., who developed MAG-5. "By going beyond the surface such as with the MAG-5 procedure, we are able to provide a natural look because the underlying structures are returned to their original position. Working against Mother Nature is always challenging, however, this is one area that science and medicine can work with Mother Nature to restore the youthful and healthy appearance you deserve."
