PANAMA CITY SURGEON FEATURED ON NATIONALLY SYNDICATED TV PROGRAM

PANAMA CITY, FL –A complicated cosmetic and reconstructive facial surgery which will be performed by local plastic surgeon, **Dr. Adil Ceydeli, M.D., M.S.**, has caught the attention of a national TV program.

The Doctors, broadcast locally on WJHG, Panama City's NBC affiliate, will feature a story about Dr. Ceydeli and his patient on Monday, February 16. The program airs at 3:00 CST. It is the first of multiple installments highlighting this case.

When the local female patient's case was first presented to the medical and surgical team of the Los Angeles based, Emmy award winning, daytime talk show, they called on Dr. Ceydeli's expertise, known to them by virtue of his having won two top surgical awards at The 2012 Aesthetic Awards in Las Vegas, NV. Hosted by Dr. Andrew Ordon, M.D., F.A.C.S. and star of *The Doctors*, THE Aesthetic Awards TM celebrate the work of the best medical aesthetic professionals in several categories.

The team contacted Dr. Ceydeli and presented the case, identifying the severity and complexity of the injuries to the patient's face. Following Dr. Ceydeli's assessment, the TV show's film crew flew to Panama City to tape the initial consultation between doctor and patient on location within the surgery center at Plastic Surgery Institute and Spa, owned by Dr. Ceydeli. The doctor and his patient were then flown to *The Doctors*' Hollywood studio. The case was presented and taped on the set of the show, and is the subject of Monday's episode.

Subsequently the L.A. film crew will return to Panama City to tape the surgical procedure at the surgery center. When the case is completed and the patient has healed, she and Dr. Ceydeli will return to *The Doctors* L.A. set to present the final outcome to the show's TV audience. The air date has not been announced.

"It is a great honor to have been asked to operate on this very complicated and very important case," states Dr. Ceydeli. "We are proud of our practice, dedicated to our patients and committed to being the best in the aesthetic industry. The opinion of our peers, fellow aesthetic professionals, means a great deal to us. Most importantly, however, is the health and well-being of our patients. This patient will one day again be confident and happy with her appearance."

A native of Turkey, Dr. Ceydeli has practiced in Panama City for seven years. He moved to the United States in 1998 to pursue his studies, achieving degrees in science, general surgery and

After finishing his Plastic Surgery training, Dr. Ceydeli also completed a prestigious Aesthetic Fellowship in Honolulu, Hawaii with the legendary Dr. Robert Flowers, making him uniquely qualified to pioneer numerous innovative procedures, both invasive and non-invasive, since his move to Northwest Florida. Working in concert with Dr. Flowers, Dr. Ceydeli invented the revolutionary "MAG-5" facial rejuvenation procedure, a breakthrough that changed the concept of aesthetic facial surgery the world over. He will be performing the revolutionary procedure on this patient.
